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YARN

Island Blend

Scarf

A Jet 902	1 x 50gm
B Lemon 908	1 x 50gm

Cowl

A Blush 904	1 x 50gm
B White 900	1 x 50gm

NEEDLES

Scarf 4mm (no 8) (US 6) circular needle at least 100 cm long

Cowl 4mm (no 8) (US 6) circular needle no more than 80 cm long

TENSION

26.5 sts and 24.5 rows to 10 cm measured over patt using 4mm (US 6) needles.

FINISHED SIZE

Completed scarf is 15 cm (6 in) wide and approx. 130 cm (51¼ in) long.
Completed cowl is 20 cm (8 in) deep and approx. 100 cm (39¼ in) in circumference.

SCARF

Using 4mm (US 6) circular needle and yarn A, cast on 345 sts.

Row 1 (WS): Using yarn A, purl.

Row 2: Using yarn A, K2tog, *(K1, yfwd, K1) in next st, sl 1, K2tog, pssso, rep from * to last 3 sts, (K1, yfwd, K1) in next st, sl 1, K1, pssso. Join in yarn B.

Row 3: Using yarn B, as row 1.

Row 4: Using yarn B, as row 2.

These 4 rows form patt.

Cont in patt until 9 patt reps have been worked in total.

Break off yarn A.

Next row: Using yarn B, purl.

Cast off.

COWL

Using 4mm (US 6) circular needle and yarn A, cast on 264 sts. Place stitch marker on needle to denote beg and end of rounds. Taking care not to twist cast-on edge, now work in rounds as follows:

Round 1 (RS): Using yarn A, knit.

Round 2: Using yarn A, sl 1, *(K1, yfwd, K1) in next st, sl 1, K2tog, pssso, rep from * to last 3 sts, (K1, yfwd, K1) in next st, sl 1, K2tog over the last st and the slipped st from the start of the round, moving the start of round marker to here.

Join in yarn B.

Round 3: Using yarn B, as round 1.

Round 4: Using yarn B, as round 2.

These 4 rounds form patt.

Cont in patt until 11 patt reps have been worked in total.

Break off yarn A.

Next round: Using yarn B, knit.

Cast off.

MAKING UP

Press as described on the ball band.
